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STUDENTS

A. NEW STUDENTS

In TED University

- The students of Faculties of Economics and Administrative Sciences and Engineering are admitted to the Faculty, and the students of Faculties of Arts and Sciences, Education and Architecture are admitted directly to the departments. Students who are admitted to the faculty choose a department after completing the English Language School and the freshman year in the common core program.
- The Faculty of Education covers the undergraduate program of Primary Education and Early Childhood Education within the Department of Elementary Education, the Guidance and Psychological Counselling undergraduate program within the Department of Educational Sciences, the undergraduate program of Mathematics Education within the Department of Mathematics and Science Education, and the Undergraduate Program of English Language Education within the Department of Foreign Language Education.
- The Faculty of Arts and Sciences covers the undergraduate programs in English Language and Literature, Mathematics, Psychology and Sociology.
- Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences covers the Common Core Program of Economics and Administrative Sciences as well as the undergraduate programs of the Departments of Economics, Business Administration and Political Science and International Relations.
- Faculty of Architecture covers the undergraduate programs of Industrial Design, Interior Architecture and Environmental Design, Architecture and City and Regional Planning Departments.
- Faculty of Engineering covers the undergraduate programs of the Computer Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Civil Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering Departments in addition to the Common Core Program of Engineering. On the other hand, students are directly admitted to the undergraduate program of the Department of Software Engineering.

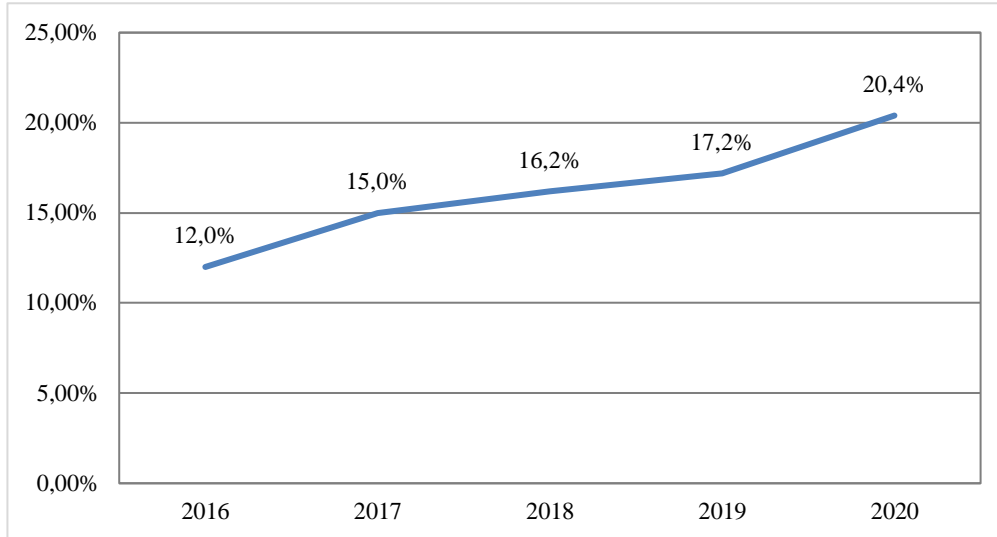

Figure 2. Ratio of Students in English Language School to the Total Number of Students in the Fall Semester of the Academic Year 2020/2021 (Last 5 Years)

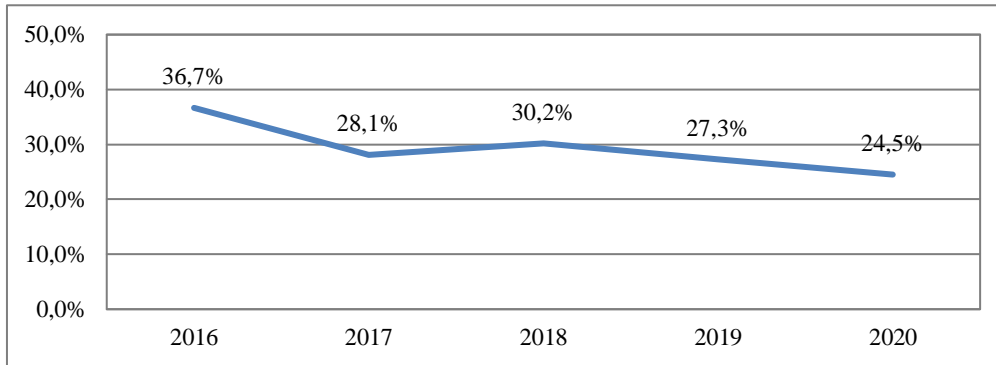
